Kayak, Canoe, and Paddleboard Racks – Usage Rules

The Gerald Park Association has three racks for kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards located at our beach area, where members can store these items for free for the season.

You can apply for spaces in one of three ways:

Phone, verbal, or other non-mailed requests cannot be honored. Applications will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority being given to non-lakefront property owners.

Please note:

- Only those GPA members who are up to date in paying their GPA taxes are permitted to reserve spaces on the beach racks.
- You must make a new request each year, since assignments for spaces on the rack expire at the end of each season.
- Kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards are stored in the racks at the risk of their owners.
- The Association assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal property left at the beach.
- Due to insurance requirements and for the safety of all members, kayaks, canoes and paddleboards can only be stored at the beach if they are on a rack. Storage against the fence is not permitted.
- Any kayaks, canoes, or paddleboards that are not stored in the rack or not removed from the park daily will be removed.
- All kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards must be removed from the racks by November 1.
